

CRITICALCONTROL ACQUIRES QM4 ENGINEERING

CALGARY, AB, May 5, 2010 – CriticalControl Solutions Corp. (TSX: CCZ) (“CriticalControl”) today announced that CriticalControl Energy Services Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of CriticalControl has acquired all of the outstanding shares of QM4 Engineering Ltd. (“QM4”) for \$0.5 Million effective May 1, 2010. QM4 is a provider of advanced algorithms which analyze natural gas production and composition information together with spatial data to determine areas of risk for production flow degradation and corrosion in complex gathering systems. QM4 is based in Calgary, AB and provides services to 4 intermediate to senior gas producers in Western Canada. In 2009, QM4 generated revenue of \$0.9 Million, \$0.4 Million of which was recurring in nature and net income before tax of \$0.1 Million.

“The addition of QM4’s algorithms to our ProStream natural gas production database will increase the utility a gas producer can generate from our repository of measurement and composition data,” said Alykhan Mamdani, President and CEO of CriticalControl. “QM4 fits directly into our existing development plan, reducing our time to market with our existing initiatives.”

As part of the transaction, four employees from QM4 will join CriticalControl’s risk assessment group based in Calgary, Alberta. The integration of QM4’s algorithms with CriticalControl’s solutions and customer base is expected to increase QM4’s penetration into the industry. In the event this initiative is successful, performance payments based on revenue growth totaling a maximum of \$3 Million will be paid to the principals of QM4 over the next 5 years. The purchase price was financed by a term loan from the Corporation’s bank at prime plus 1.55%, repayable on December 31, 2010.
